ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE

Regulating traffic entering and leaving Lula Lake Road from the driveway between the gasoline service station and the shopping center in Lookout Mountain, Georgia.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lookout Mountain, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained:


Section 1. All vehicular traffic other than emergency vehicles are herewith prohibited from entering the driveway between the gasoline service station and the shopping center in Lookout Mountain, Georgia, from Lula Lake Road.


Section 2. The Chief of Police is herewith authorized and directed to cause and permit to be erected signs at the entrance to said driveway necessary in the Chief's opinion to give notice of and to enforce the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after its adoption and approval by at least three members of the Council of the City after two readings at least one week apart.
