Daniel Cate's Top 10 List for Disposal of Trash & Yard Debris

- Pick-up is on Tuesday and Friday. If Trash Day falls on a holiday, pick-up will occur on the next business day.
- Only household trash can be placed in a
 City-provided garbage can. No dead deer,
 frozen cats, ducks, or raccoons. Daniel
 says he does not provide taxidermy dropoff services, but he can provide
 recommendations.
- All household trash must be bagged, including kitty litter!
- Disposal of needles must follow the protocol of the manufacturer and should not be put in trash can. Fairyland Pharmacy can order approve disposal containers.
- If needed, additional cans may be purchased by contacting the City at 706–820–1586, ext. 3
- Follow the 4 x 4 Rule of Thumb for limbs and branches. They cannot be greater than four inches in diameter and four feet in length.
- Leaves and brush must be kept in separate piles. Daniel says, "Combined piles of sticks and leaves will require hospital visit for leaf machine"

Yard debris should not be left on road, placed in a stormwater ditch, or on the sidewalk, nor obstruct a fire hydrant, stop sign, culvert, or telephone pole.

- No building materials from demolition, construction, remodeling by homeowner or contractor, hazardous waste, paint, mattress and box springs, tires, etc.
- Follow these rules of engagement to help us keep our community Fairy Nice and Magical!
