CITY OF LOOKOUT MOUNTAIN, GEORGIA ORDINANCE NO. 50

AN ORDINANCE

To repeal in its entirety Ordinance No. 49 of the City of Lookout Mountain, Georgia, levying and imposing an excise tax upon the sale of malt beverages within the City.

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court of Georgia has declared unconstitutional certain provisions of H.B. No. 329 amending Georgia Laws 1935, p. 73, whereby the City was directed to impose an excise tax on malt beverages.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Lookout Mountain, Georgia, and it is hereby ordained:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 49 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Lookout Mountain, Georgia is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective ten (10) days after its adoption and approval by at least three members of the Council of the City after two readings at least one week apart.
